- UNCOM and all of its members serve over 50,000 people, annually.
- We serve people in all 36 zip codes of Milwaukee County from the North Side to the South Side from birth to twilight.
- UNCOM agencies are immersed in over 175 areas of impact through programming in Advocacy & Engagement, Youth Services, Family Services, Education, Financial Stability, Health & Safety, Racial Equity & Inclusion and Strengthening Neighborhoods.
- Representation Matters! 38% of the UNCOM Board of Directors are people of color. 80% of UNCOM home office staff are people of color.
- The UNCOM home office and its member agencies employ 200 people from our community and utilize almost 1,000 volunteers every year.

# Helping Young Adults Find Employment

The United Neighborhood Centers of Milwaukee’s Home office works with Milwaukee’s underserved youth and young adults through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title 1B Out of School Youth (OSY) program to help them finish high school and secure training and credentials in order to proceed on a path to sustainable employment. Our skilled professionals direct these youth through a variety of career options including the medical, early childhood, hospitality and construction fields. In 2021 we worked with XXX participants in the program. Of those XXX, we helped 153 obtain employment by year end.
